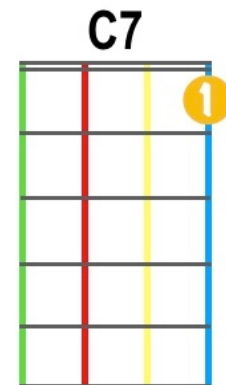
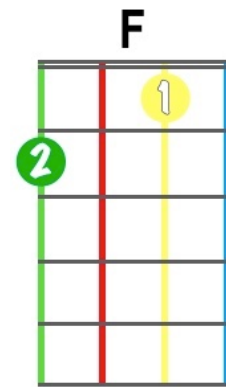
V3: [F] Them Frisco girls ain't [F] got no comb (hoo!)
